### Grassroots: A Community Based Approach to a Greener Future

Todd Kelly from Carteret County Soil and Water Conservation District will present information on stormwater control measures for the home owners and speak about a new Community Conservation Assistance Program.

Sandy Kunkle from the Carteret County Tree Awareness Group, a Crossroads partner organization, will speak about the 2008 Champion Tree program and efforts to develop a county-wide Tree Preservation Ordinance.
